## Policies (examples)

- Nothing is off the board
- See something you don't understand ask!
- Everything in backlog first
- Priority score is visible on committed work challenge welcome!
- Define what 'good' and 'finished' looks like
- Pull from Committed:Ready column NOT Backlog
- Only Executive can modify WIP Limits
- Min. monthly meetings to populate Committed or as needed to maintain WIP
- Add name on tasks if assigned or want to volunteer

Model activity/workflow
Low cost holding pattern
Classification: Standard, fixed date, expedite
Enables self-organization
Balances urgent vs date-driven work
Welcome changing priorities/new items
Focus on finishing in-flight before starting new work
WIP limits increase flow/productivity
Plan Do Check Adjust (PDCA) Cycle
